The most common trucks used in the early 1900s were archbar trucks as shown in fig 2 These were made of pressed steel and bar components that were bolted together Although they worked well, archbar trucks required a lot of maintenance Their bolts needed frequent tightening, as they tended to work loose with the shocks and jolts of operation

### **Electric Vehicles in the Postal Service - USPS**

1974, the Postal Service ordered 350 electric Jeeps from American Motors Corporation Delivery of these DJ-5Es, also called "Electrucks," began in 1975 - with the first 10 trucks placed in service in Evansville, Indiana, that July - and was completed in early 1976 Congressman Philip Hayes of Indiana commended the Postal
